Stock may be used for wildlife habitat, erosion control, reforestation, windbreaks, landscaping, Christmas trees, etc. All trees and shrubs sold are to be used for these conservation practices. Trees and shrubs are sold with the understanding that they will not be removed from the planted site for resale with the roots attached. Orders are filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. The District reserves the right to refund payment on items if they should become unavailable. Because the District cannot check planting locations, guard against improper planting or handling, variations in sizes due to the growing season and/or weather related problems, the District will not be responsible for replacement or refunds of orders after distribution. Returned checks WILL NOT be resubmitted and will incur a \$20 fee, followed by the need for a cash or money order payment. Please call our office if you have any questions.
